- Demonstrate experience in implementing and managing Geographic Information Systems (GIS), evidenced by at least five (5) working GIS deployments within organizations in developing countries.
- Demonstrate presence in the firm of personnel with the following expertise: Project Manager (Team Lead), GIS Specialist. IT Infrastructure Specialist. Data Analyst.
